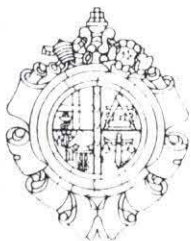

The purpose of this letter is to make a request to Kellogg Foundation for financing a group fellowship for 6 health professionals, to attend the XIII World Conference on Health Education in Houston, Texas and visit 3 health education programs in the cities of Laredo-Texas, Chapel Hill-North Carolina and New York City.

Four of the selected participants are professionals who belong to the Faculty of Medicine; one, belongs to the School of Psychology of the Catholic University of Chile and one participant is a nurse from the School of Nursing of the University of Chile. The whole group has been interested in initiating collaborative work in the area of Selfcare, through the Kellogg funded Health Selfcare Education Project that is being developed at the Faculty of Medicine of our University.

The objectives of this group seminar are the following :

- Get international feedback in relation to the experience obtained by the Health Selfcare Education Project of the Catholic University of Chile.



- Initiate networking activities with health professionals of other countries who are working in health education with latino population.
- Increase knowledge and widen the scope of the group participants regarding health selfcare education, by attending the XIII World Congress in Health Education, and by visiting creative health education programs in selected institutions in USA.

I believe that this group experience will be of great benefit for the selected professionals, with the consequent profit for the Schools and Universities involved, and for the improvement of health care in our country.

The group seminar is planned to last 21 days (August 26 and September 15th., 1988).

The financial aid required from Kellogg Foundation to make this activity possible is US\$ 27.850 (twenty seven thousand eight hundred and fifty dollars).
