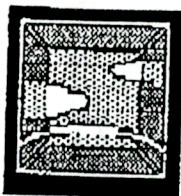

Dear Mrs. Franco,

Thank you very much for your letter of October 25, 1991.

I understand that you are interested in providing a service to your library customers, to distribute copies of articles of Springer-Verlag journals. The clientele does not only consist of Professors and scholars of the University, but also of "external" users.

According to the Copyright Laws, a single copy can be made by each individual scholar for educational use only. However, if your library would offer this service for the individual scholar, and do this on a regular basis, copyright permission must be obtained from the original copyright holder. The copyright holder may charge for the use of the journal article, if it so pleases.

Therefore, I must conclude that you may indeed offer this service to your customers from inside or outside the University, but you may have to charge them for the actual copy and for the copyright fee, which will have to be paid to the Copyright Holder.


In order for us to find out what kind of fee is appropriate for the use that your customers are making of our copyrighted material, I would like to know if you charge the clients anything for the copies itself.

Also, I will be interested to know a little bit more about the total volume under discussion here. How many copies of articles, from Springer-Verlag journals do you make for your customers on a monthly or weekly basis??

If you can possibly provide me with this kind of information, I am sure that we can come to an amicable arrangement.

Thank you once again for contacting us directly with this problem.

For ACS journals and books, the cost per article copy is printed at the bottom of the first page of each article or chapter, at the end of the numeric code. For magazines, the cost per article is listed on the masthead page.

WHAT...

CCC is a centralized photocopy authorization service. The not-for-profit CCC was established by photocopy-users, authors, and publishers at the suggestion of the U.S. Congress that a mechanism be created to facilitate compliance with the copyright law.

WHEN...

Once you are registered with CCC, you have immediate authorization to copy from over 1,500,000 domestic and foreign publications. The publications include books, magazines, newsletters and journals. They cover fields from medical, scientific, trade, business, educational and computer related areas.

HOW...

CCC provides you with a Catalog of Publisher Information (COPI), which lists registered titles and their copying fees.

You may report your photocopy activity by a log sheet. The following data elements would be required on your log: standard number, year of publication, number of pages copied, and number of copies made. You may choose to report via an electronic method. Specifications are provided upon request.

There is a one time registration fee of \$30 and a \$75 annual membership fee which will include the cost of two COPI's.

WHY...

The copyright law makes provisions for copying where no permission is required under limited "fair use" conditions described in Section 107. Certain libraries are also granted no-fee copying rights under the special conditions described in Section 108. However, the need to obtain authorizations arise frequently when copies are used for meetings, presentations, clients, workshops, and classroom uses, or when provided through interlibrary loan.

CCC eliminates the repeated need to seek permission to photocopy from individual publishers which can be a time consuming and costly process. CCC distributes royalty fees to the appropriate publishers for you.

WHERE...

CCC is the only service of its kind in the U.S. Where else can you obtain permissions to photocopy from thousands of copyright owners through one single source?

CCC's Transactional Reporting Service is used by document suppliers, academic institutions, government agencies, individuals and corporations.

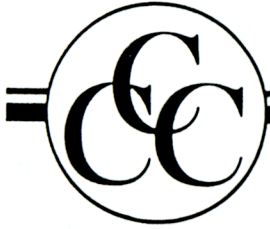

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING CCC-LOG SHEET

This log is intended to assist in the recording of photocopy activity authorized by the Copyright Clearance Center, Inc. (CCC). After photocopying an individual article\*, proceed as follows:

- 1) Enter your CCC ACCOUNT NUMBER.

If you do not have a number, contact CCC at the address below.

- 2) Enter your LOG NUMBER and DATE.

This data is for your information only.

- 3) Enter the CCC TITLE ID, the STANDARD NUMBER, the PUBLICATION YEAR, the NUMBER OF PAGES COPIED (in a particular article), and the NUMBER OF COPIES MADE (of a particular article).

The *number of pages copied* is a required entry only when there is a per-page fee. Please do not group articles together on one line of a log. Each line item is meant to include one transaction, i.e., when one article (or portion thereof) is copied.

- 4) Send accumulated log sheets to CCC monthly.
- 5) If log sheet data fields are left empty, CCC will assume the current year to be the publication year, the number of pages to be one (1), and the number of copies to be one (1).
- 6) Upon receipt of your report, CCC will issue an invoice showing a detailed listing of the charges incurred and the total authorization fees due.

\* The word "article" refers to any portion of a publication that is being copied (such as column, page, article, chapter, or any series of consecutive pages).
